Five spots under each track will be reserved for Mount St. Joseph University undergraduates each year. Students will have two options toward acceptance:

EARLY DECISION TRACK

Qualifications

- Graduate in the spring semester prior to possible MU-COM matriculation.
- Minimum total GPA of 3.70, with a minimum science GPA of 3.50.
- Minimum MCAT score of 505, with a minimum biology score of 127.
- Acceptance is contingent upon maintaining grades and completing pre-medicine requirements.

Benefits

- Guaranteed interview in September of senior year if application is complete.
- Guaranteed admission decision within one week of interview.
